Fees & Admissions (2026 Academic Year)

- Fees for the 2026 academic year will be published in April 2026.
- To reserve a place, parents are required to pay a deposit of GHS 3,000 via:
- Mobile Money (MoMo)
- Bank Transfer

This deposit is non-refundable but will be credited toward your child's first term fees.

Full payment details, along with our admissions policy, will be provided upon application.

Refund & Payment Policy

- Deposit: The GHS 3,000 deposit is non-refundable but credited toward first term fees once the child is enrolled.
- Withdrawal Before Start of Term: If a child is withdrawn after the deposit is paid but before the start of term, the deposit will not be refunded or transferred.

- Withdrawal During Term: Fees already paid for the current term are non-refundable, even if the child leaves mid-term.
- Late Payments: School fees must be paid in full by the deadline stated on the invoice. A late payment charge of 5% per month may be applied to outstanding balances.
- Exclusion for Non-Payment: The school reserves the right to suspend or withdraw a child if fees remain unpaid after repeated reminders.
- Payment Methods: Fees may be paid via Mobile Money (MoMo) or Bank Transfer.
